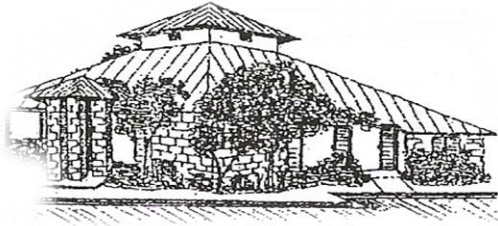

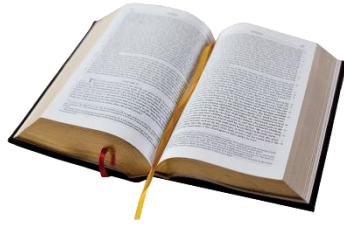

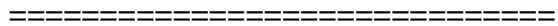
“Wednesday Night Bible Study Group

We will start the year with a trip through Luke’s Gospel. New people are most welcome to come and be part of us.”



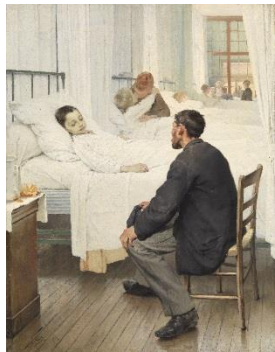
Annual Reports
