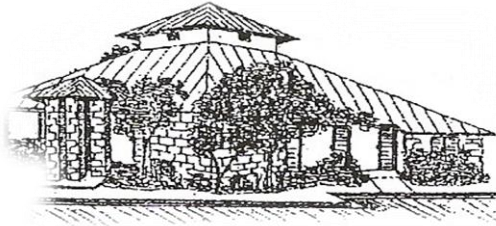

SUPPORT FOR PASTOR SEO

I appeal to you on behalf of Pastor Priscilla Seo, the Korean Pastor of the Korean Faith Community associated with us TCCM. As many will know, her home in Idalia was significantly affected by the Townsville floods with about 30 cm of water, including sewerage effluent, through the low set home. The walls have been stripped and all floor coverings, including tiles have been removed. The quoted cost for the total repair of the property is \$106,000. We have been able to find a local builder who is willing to do any repairs stage by stage as they have the money. Stage 1 involved re-sheeting the walls (no plaster or paint) and repairing one bathroom. That comes to just under \$22,000 of which the family have about two thirds.

Working Bee Saturday 22nd June

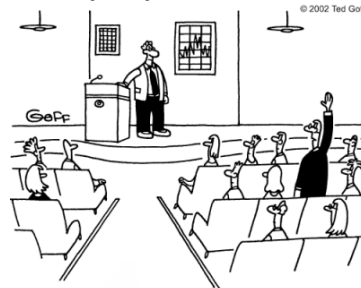
