

Well, what has been on the cards for a couple of weeks has come to pass, and our "In church" services are cancelled for an indefinite time.

You might have heard cheerful folk looking on the bright side, and pointing out that:

When Shakespeare was quarantined at home because of a plague outbreak, he wrote King Lear. And,

When Cambridge University was closed in the 1700s because of another plague outbreak, Isaac Newton had to work from home and that was why he was in his garden when an apple fell on him and he propounded the Law of Gravity. And,
