But we can't order items from their fabulous Food Hall, for obvious reasons. Woolies and Coles stock pre-prepared gourmet meals now, but when Leisa and I started going out, M&S and Waitrose were the only source of that lovely grub.

I lived in a rather nice cottage in a South Downs village near Chichester (next door to a pub, over-the-road from a Baptist Chapel, we didn't go to either). Leisa would come down at weekends from London, and for the first few weeks she thought that she was dating a cordon bleu chef. Until she felt bold enough to take over the kitchen, opened the waste bin, and discovered a load of empty M&S and Waitrose boxes. I had been pretending to be something that I wasn't, to impress her.
