RICHARD'S RAMBLE

Many 21stC ethical or conscience questions aren't answered exactly in the Bible, because they concern issues which weren't faced directly in the 1stC CE or in the times of the OT patriarchs or prophets. I think I've related the tale of Rev Paddi Mullan being berated at an AGM by a lady who told him that "Direct Debits aren't in the Bible!" when Paddi urged giving by regular direct debit. Paddi retorted, "Refrigerators aren't in the Bible, but you've got one of them, haven't ya?" So we come to COVID vaccination. You won't find Pfizer or Astra Zeneca, even in the genealogies. And it's sad fact that, certainly in the USA, anti-vaxxers claim to have a Christian remit. But there are three passages which contradict their claims. First, and most

important because it is a Dominical injunction, Matthew 22:

And one of them, a lawyer, asked him a question to test him. "Teacher, which is the great commandment in the Law?" And he said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the great and first commandment. And a second is like it: You shall love your neighbour as yourself. On these two commandments depend all the Law and the Prophets."

You are not loving your neighbour as yourself if you refuse a vaccination which protects those who come in contact with you.

Second, 1 Corinthians 6: Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; you were bought at a price. Therefore honour God with your bodies.

To negligently heighten disease risk, is not honouring to God.

And third, Philippians 4: *Finally, brothers* and sisters, whatever is true ... think about such things. If you're reading anti-vax articles in social media, they are not true.

So when it's your turn, listen to Jesus and Paul and get that jab!
