And of course, many of you will have Skyped or Facetimed distant family and friends. It's always fun to meet someone in the flesh who has previously only been a face and voice on a screen.

Job had that fun (well, it wasn't exactly fun if you read the context in Job 43) when he said to God, "My ears had heard of you, but now my eyes have seen you." And an even better-known instance of longing to transform a relationship from being remote pen-pals, is Job 19: "I know that my redeemer lives,
