# From the Minister's Desk

I had the privilege of attending the Townsville Combined Churches Ministry Breakfast at Northreach Baptist. This group is quite unlike other 'ministers' fraternals' I have attended in the past - the main goal is unity among the churches of our beautiful city and there is a clear drive towards evangelism. It was shared with us that of 230,000 Townsville residents, only 10,000 are in churches any given Sunday (National Church Life Survey 2021). This reminded me of another figure that was shared with me about our city, apparently in the old Thuringowa region there were 3,000+ Uniting Church members (Census 2016).

This speaks to me of the missional need in our city, and when we consider what we see in the news and in the Bulletin - it's really no wonder! When discussing the missional needs in Townsville, our speaker Ps Pierre from Northreach shared with us the strategy that the group had landed on: Reach the City, Plant the City, Serve the City and Transform the City. Table groups consisting of different churches and different denominations looked at the different ways we could exercise this strategy and we shared our discussions with the large group. What we all agreed on was one thing that we could all do and touches on each of these strategies. It is accessible for churches of twenty, fifty or 100+, and everyone can do it from their very homes! Prayer.

It was agreed across the Christian churches of Townsville that prayer would be the way to reach, plant, serve and transform our city - at least in these initial phases. So if you are a praying person, there are some great opportunities to come alongside other Christians and pray - Combined Churches Monthly Prayer 1st Tues of the Month, 7 am at Northreach, YWAM Cafe or North Shore Tavern, Prayer for Council - Oct 16 and Nov 20, and our own Monday Prayer Meetings at 12. Let us use prayer to pave the way fro mission and outreach in our community!
